Parent/Provider Child Care Contract

This contract is entered into by and between _____

and Jeannie Brown & Deborah Miller (Rising Star Learning Center) hereinafter "Provider", for the purpose of securing arrangements for child care of _____

The Parent(s) Agrees:

1. To pay the provider at the rate of \$125.00 per week for child care services for their child. \$30.00 per day Part-Time. \$65.00 per week after school care. If child is not potty trained add \$15.00 per week.
2. An annual registration fee of \$85.00 is required for your child. This fee is non-refundable
 3. To pay an annual fee of \$_____ for supplies.
 4. To pay the provider in advance on Monday at time of drop off and to pay a **Late Fee** of \$10.00 per day for everyday after.
 5. To pay the provider \$_____.00 wk or \$_____.00 day for holidays, vacation and days when the child is absent due to illness, vacation or parent's choice. Such holidays shall consist of the following:
New Year's Eve, New Years Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Veterans Day, Thanksgiving Weekend, Christmas Eve and Christmas Day.
 6. To pay a **Late Pick-up fee** of \$ 5.00 per 15 minutes when the child is picked late.
* Late fee may be waived if prior notice is given to Provider by the Parent.
 7. To pay a \$40.00 fee if your check is returned as NSF by your bank, plus bank costs/charges. *Please note only cash will be accepted after one return check.
 8. To provide the following supplies for their child/ren:
Infants & Toddlers: Diapers (pack), Wipes (pack), Ointment, Formula, Jar Food.
Everyone: Small pillow, small blanket, tooth brush and an extra set of clothing. (*Over the counter med's, when needed)
Winter time: Jacket and warm hat. **Summer Time:** Towel, swim suit and sun block.
 9. To have **backup child care arranged** in the event of an emergency or illness of the provider or providers family.
 10. To strictly respect and follow Provider's Illness Policy. **There will be no exceptions.**
